## Eph. 2:1-13

- I. Real
  - A. Occurring or existing in actuality.
  - B. Of or relating to practical or everyday concerns or activities
    - 1. Are you a REAL child of God, and are you REALLY empowered by Him?
  - C. What's Real and what's not?
    - 1. 1 Kings 3:23-27
      - a) The REAL mother revealed herself with selflessness; with love!
      - b) The REAL Father revealed Himself with selflessness; with Love!
    - 2. Gen. 3:1-5
      - a) The question of your eternity.
        - (1) Matt. 16:13-15
          - (a) Who do you say that He is?
      - b) If God Really is who He says He is, Then we Really have some power to be growing into. A lot of untapped potential!
        - (1) Do we live like we truly believe Him?
      - c) John 5:24 "Verily Verily" = Truly Truly
        - (1) Your reality, your day-to-day living WILL be dictated by what you truly believe about God and Jesus.
          - (a) What is your REAL life, your daily life, revealing about what you believe?
          - (b) Proverbs 27:19
          - (c) A REAL branch is connected to a REAL vine and bears REAL fruit.
- II. The Potential
  - A. Every day we have a REAL potential. (The strength of the mighty man drawing back the bow Psalm 127:3-5)
    - 1. Potential to choose... Duet. 30:15-20
      - a) God's Power, God's Life, God's Solutions, God's Thoughts, God's Perspective, God's Will instead of your own.
  - B. Freedom
    - 1. Basically, We have been empowered to live freely
      - a) Galatians 5:1 & 13
      - b) 2 Corin. 3:17
  - C. "Knowledge is Power?"
    - 1. 1 Peter 1:1-4
      - a) Knowledge = Epignosis Knowledge, recognition, discernment, acknowledgement

- (1) Knowledge vs Acknowledge It's not just about knowing information, but about what you decide about that information.
  - (a) Acknowledge = to recognize as genuine or valid.
- b) The Power of God can only be walked in after we have acknowledged it's validity and availability.
  - (1) The apostles were not able to preach the gospel under the power of the Holy Spirit until they had pursued and received Him. (Acts 2)
  - (2) Our knowledge of God and His love for us should be continuously expanding every day.
    - (a) So our ability to operate in God's power should be expanding every day as well.
- D. Exactly what is the measure of the potential of God's power in our lives?
  - 1. How deeply do you love and trust God?
  - 2. James 4:8 "Draw nigh to God, and he will draw night to you..."
    - a) The power is found in His presence!
      - (1) The closer you are, the more of His glory you can reflect.
