 - a) James 4:1-3 We fight and war with each other when we loos sight of God being our source; when we fail to have an abundance mindset based on God's love for us. We don't ask God because we don't believe that He loves us. When we do ask its with the wrong motives because we aren't grateful for what God is already providing.
- 5. Not staying connected to the vine
 - a) God's provision is in His presence
- 6. Not living in Freedom through Christ
