I. Luke Warm

A. Rev. 3:14-22

1. Our blessing can distract us, and cause us to forget how badly we need God.
 - a) We live in the U.S. aka - the land of opportunity.
 - (1) Mindset that we can do whatever we want, and think that we can achieve what ever we want. That we can be successful on our own. - Self has become the ultimate authority (god).
 - (2) We are all capable of a deep trust and faith in God, but usually have to be forced into it by our circumstances.
 - b) Without God we are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked.
 - (1) If I don't understand that a vehicle needs Gasoline in order to work, then I will never take it to the gas station and will be frustrated when it doesn't work.
 - (a) If we never recognize our need for God then we won't see the need to pursue Him, and will be frustrated when our life is empty and meaningless.
 - (2) A healthy dose of humility is good, just not very fun.

B. His correction is an act of love

1. Love does not support every action and desire!
 - a) Love is patient and kind but it does not seek her own, does not rejoice in iniquity, and rejoices in the truth!
 - (1) It has restrictions and boundaries like a road has rules and guard rails
2. He is asking us to invest in things that are far more valuable than what this world can offer.

1. Before the flood Noah looked foolish. Wasting his time, energy, resources, etc.

 - a) "self" cannot be the ultimate authority.
